

- The system of water flowing through porous rock The steep slope starting at the edge
- 7 of the continental shelf
- The measure of the amount of salts dissolved in a liquid
- 11 The difference in level between a high tide and a low tide
- The area of land that drains into a body of water
- The area between the coast and the edge of the basin
- 16 The process in which eroded material is dropped or left
- 18 The highest part of a wave
- 19 The tumble of water when a wave collapses on shore
- 21 Areas of water occurring in low areas. They are important habitats for many species Smooth waves near the shore
- 23 Water that doesn't soak into the ground or evaporate, but flows across Earth's surface

- The long range of mountains dividing 1 North America
- Wide, open features of the deep sea
- The distance from crest to the next
- 5 Generally a flat area of land that is prone to flooding
- Pollutant is from a small, defined area
- The amount of water discharged by a watershed
- 10 Narrow, steep-sided canyons formed along some ocean ridges
- In the ground, the level beneath which porous rocks are full of water
- The winds that push ocean currents toward the west
- 17 Allowing material (such as water) to pass through
